Presenting Complaint: Wellness Check

Clinical Concern/Differentials: Main clinical question/concern (Hip dysplasia screen for breeding female.)

HIPS AND STIFLES, 28th January 2026: lateral and VD views, for a total of 7 images provided.

COMPARISON: None available.

**FINDINGS:**

There are multiple physis that remain open, considered normal for the age of the patient.

**COXOFEMORAL JOINTS**

There is adequate acetabular coverage of the femoral head in both coxofemoral joints. There is no evidence of periarticular new bone formation or other aggressive bone lesions. Both sacroiliac joints are within normal limits. Pelvic bones included, within normal limits.

There are multiple, small, mineral opaque structures superimposed with the muscular structures on the lateral views, of the caudal aspect of the thigh and crural region, that seem to be located in the hair, in some of the VD view.

**STIFLES**

The intra and extra-articular soft tissues are normal. There are no abnormalities of the osseous structures. The subchondral bone is within normal limits. The stifles show a normal alignment. The patellae are centered in the femoral trochlea. The popliteal lymph nodes are normal.

The lumbosacral spine included is unremarkable.

**CONCLUSIONS:**

1. Unremarkable coxofemoral joints and stifles.
2. Unremarkable lumbosacral spine.
3. Multiple mineral opaque structures superimposed with the muscles, most likely artefactual due to dirty hair.
